#### **AGENDA ADOPTION**

Rich Sells made a motion to adopt the October 17, 2024, BCAB meeting agenda. Brian Turrisi seconded the motion. All were in favor and the motion passed.

#### **DIRECTOR'S REPORT**

#### • **DEPARTMENT UPDATE:**

Flying Frog 5K: Rembold said the event was successfully held and the weather was perfect. He said 60+/- runners participated in the race. He mentioned that for the first time ever they had a County Administrator (Mike Moore) run the race. He observed that County Council member Logan Cunningham ran the race; County Council member Anna Maria Tabernik, volunteered; and David Nelems and Mark Bailey represented the Board at the event.

**Closure Markers:** Rembold mentioned that the new LED closure markers for the end of the runway are very visible. He stated that the markers will save time and energy and are good equipment to have.

#### • TERMINAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT UPDATE:

Rembold reported that the project is progressing on schedule. He shared a slideshow of the construction progress. He pointed out that having a crane on site is moving the steel assembly quickly.

He commented that the pedestrian crosswalks are taking shape, the sidewalks are being poured, the new roadway is getting the base put in, and curbing is being installed.

#### • AIRPORTS' BUSINESS UPDATE:

**Title VI Plan:** Rembold explained that it is a federal requirement for grants applications, and HXD is required to have its own plan independent of the County's Title VI Plan. He mentioned that the plan will be posted on the Airport's website once it is approved by the FAA.

**Breakfast Club:** Rembold mentioned that the Breakfast Club event is on Nov 17th and indicated that volunteers are needed.

**ARW Hangars:** He stated that the project is progressing. He mentioned that a grant application was submitted, and \$1.38 million for site work has been awarded.

**PFC #6:** Rembold stated that Passenger Facility Charges #6 applies to HXD, is under final review by the FAA, and should be implemented in November.

#### **ITEM BACKGROUND:**

The Airports Board will review and recommend approval of SCAC Grant 24-062 at its monthly meeting scheduled for Nov 21, 2024.

#### **PROJECT / ITEM NARRATIVE:**

Beaufort Executive Airport has a crisis-level shortage of hangar space. All hangars are occupied, and there is a 68-person waiting list. The construction of new hangars is necessary to provide Beaufort County citizens with much-needed aircraft hangar space. SC Aeronautics Commission recognizes hangar development as a project that will help to increase the viability of a general aviation airport and supports this effort.

#### **FISCAL IMPACT:**

Total Project Cost (\$1,982,495.00). Project Funding Sources include:

- (70%) SCAC Grant 24-062 \$1,387,747.00

- (30%) Sponsor Share \$594,748.00 (designated ARPA funds)

#### **ITEM BACKGROUND:**

On July 15, 2024, County Council approved acceptance of a \$5,000,000 BIL Airport Terminal Program Grant to be used during Phase I of the Terminal Improvements Project. This Change Order will use a portion of those funds. The Airports Board will review and recommend approval of this change order at its monthly meeting scheduled for Nov 21, 2024.

#### **PROJECT / ITEM NARRATIVE:**

This Change Order provides three passenger boarding bridges (jet bridges), new apron lighting, and an emergency response antenna system. These items were not in the initial Phase I budget, and they are important additions to the project. They provide customer comfort and convenience, safety for airline workers, and enhanced communications for first responders.

#### **FISCAL IMPACT:**

The total value of this Change Order is \$3,367,113. The grant provides 95% (\$3,198,757.35) of the funding. The remainder (\$168,355.65) is provided by airport revenues.
