Director's Report - Hilton Head Island Airport Project Update

- ❖ COVID-19: Mr. Rembold briefed the board members on the 3 airlines' commitment:
 - o to deliver a new standard of clean environment for customers
 - o to provide masks and require them to be worn on flights
 - o to offer sanitizing wipes or gels for passengers as well.
- ❖ TSA updates: TSA has implemented changes to the security screening process that reduce the potential for cross-contamination at the security checkpoint in an effort to help prevent the spread of COVID-19. Also, TSA officers at checkpoints are now using facial protection. Travelers are encouraged to wear face protection to the checkpoint as well.
