The meeting was called to order by Commissioner Bright @ 18:10.

Commissioner Peeples motioned to accept the agenda with the addition of a presentation by Fraser Construction.

Pinewood Renovations

Chief Rountree invited Fraser Construction and Court Atkins Architects to the meeting to make a presentation of the renovation proposal at the Pinewood station.

Court Atkins Group presented the floor plan which would include a two story addition while mostly leaving the existing structure as is, with a few minor changes. This approach will allow firefighters to still operate out of the station while renovations are being done.

The renovations would be done under a design-build process where a budget and goals would are set, and the design team then goes out to bid(s) to get the best possible prices.

Time Frame – permitting and final costs would take an estimate of six months. After that 7-9 months for the addition and renovations. We would have the option to do it in two phases to help with financial costs.

The proposed cost (includes 10% contingency) is \$1,399,000.

Chief Rountree met with Palmetto State Bank and got a quote for \$1.4 million for 15 years. The estimated annual cost would be \$131,377.

The Fire District paid off two notes which would allow for a total of \$112 annually without increasing taxes.

Chief Rountree will meet with a few other banks to get quotes from them as well.

The Commission asked Fraser Construction if they could break out the numbers to separate the permitting/design costs vs. construction since this project would be split between two fiscal years. There is \$67,000 slotted in this years budget to use towards the renovations.

(Members of Fraser Construction and Court Atkins left the meeting at 19:10)

Commissioner Harris motioned to accept the July 25th minutes.
