CONTINUING EDUCATION PROGRAM DATES 2025

Days/ Time: Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday – **10:00** until approx. **12:30 EXCEPT June, July, and August (AHA Block)**

June – August is our AHA Block - These are lengthy classes with timeframe determined by AHA course guidelines. Classes will begin at 10:00 and end approx. 16:00, depending on the number of students each day/ skill stations. All personnel should plan for a full day course.

Please remember there is no partial credit for any CEP class, you must be in seat at the beginning of class, stay for the entire class and sign roster/ rosters at end of class to obtain credit. CEP guidelines are set by The Department of Public Health and will be followed by Beaufort County EMS; all core content is determined by the National Continued Competency Program.

Length of Class

Timeframes for all CEP classes are approximate. Due to course content some classes will be longer than others.

Most CEP classes will end by 12:30.

Occasionally a class will last longer or end early.

You MUST be ON TIME and attend the entire class from start to finish.

AHA Block classes; BLS, ACLS, PALS, will last the required time set by the AHA. These are lengthy courses designed to cover classroom and skills. All personnel will attend the skills session. This gives an opportunity to refresh skills which may not be used on a regular basis and introduce new/ helpful techniques.

If you are not able to attend a CEP class you must submit a Training Exemption request prior to the class, and it must be approved by the Training Officer.

If you have an emergency and are not able to attend call as soon as practical.
