Volunteers Sought for Litter Cleanup Event

The Beaufort County Public Works Department and Keep Beaufort County Beautiful are partnering with the City of Beaufort and the Friends of the Spanish Moss Trail to lead a litter cleanup event. Organizers are seeking volunteers to help clean a portion of the Spanish Moss Trail from Roseida Road to Parris Island Gateway.

The Spanish Moss Trail is a rails-to-trails project with a paved, dedicated pedestrian and bike trail connecting neighborhoods, parks and businesses in Beaufort, Port Royal, and Burton. The trail offers public access for residents and visitors to enjoy water and salt marsh views, while providing an enjoyable way to exercise and experience Beaufort County's natural beauty.
