Beaufort County Offers Free Secure Shredding Event

The Beaufort County Public Works Department Solid Waste and Recycling Division continues to offer secure document shredding for County residents.

The next document shredding event will be held Saturday, April 8, from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. (or until trucks are filled) at the Shanklin Convenience Center Site, 80 Shanklin Road, Beaufort.

Any types or colors of paper, file folders or envelopes are acceptable. Staples or paper clips do not need to be removed. Materials can be brought in any container or bag and will be emptied into roll carts for immediate shredding.

All materials will be shredded on site until trucks reach capacity. Only residential quantities will be accepted. No materials from commercial businesses will be accepted. No electronics will be collected at this event.
