CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Ed Pappas called the meeting to order at 3:04 p.m.

REVIEW OF AGENDA

Chairman Pappas asked if there were any changes to the Agenda and there were none.

REVIEW OF MINUTES

Chairman Pappas asked if there were any changes to the Minutes from the August 13, 2015 Board meeting. Hearing none, Mr. Baker made a motion and Mr. Mathews seconded the motion

to accept the Minutes as written from the August 13, 2015 Board meeting. The motion was carried unanimously to accept the minutes as written from the August 13, 2015, Board meeting (FOR: Pappas, Brown, Baker, Bender, Glover, Mathews, O'Kane, Stewart).

GENERAL DISCUSSION

Chairman Ed Pappas stated the Board member Mr. Bill Ladson resigned from the Board on October 2, 2015. Mr. Ladson represented District 1.

Mr. Alan Eisenman gave a financial update of the Rural and Critical Land Preservation Program. As of August 31, 2015 there was a total amount of \$11.2 million in funds. Of that, \$9.8 million was unrestricted and \$1.3 million was restricted. These numbers do not include the \$20 million referendum that was approved in November 2014.

Ms. Amanda Flake gave an update on the passive park development. At this time the Planning Department is working on bringing three passive parks online; Crystal Lake, Okatie Preserve, and Fort Fremont. Crystal Lake is ready to go to bid for Phase 2 which includes renovation of the building to include an interpretive center, offices for the Beaufort County Open Land Trust and the Beaufort County Soil and Water Conservation District, solar panels on the roof, security cameras, and either a pavilion or tower. Fort Fremont is moving forward and the project to address the comments from SHPO (State Historic Preservation Office) is proceeding as planned. The Planning Department is working on getting a Manure Management Plan for Okatie Preserve as a requirement by the Town of Bluffton.

Mr. Mike Mathews stated that Ms. Lisa Lord was not present today because she was invited to speak at the Land Trust Alliance International in Sacramento, California about this Program, which was a great honor. Mr. Mathews updated the Board on the communication plan status and TPL study. He stated that the new online Greenprint map should be up and running by the end of October. This will also coincide with the launch of the new Rural and Critical Land Preservation Program website. Mr. Ken Driggers discussed the TPL study that will consist of the economic benefits of the Program within Beaufort County. Once specifics of the study are identified, a price will be negotiated. Mr. Driggers hopes that this study will be under way by the end of the year.

Mr. Barry Johnson stated that if any of the Board members had any questions about the property to be discussed in Executive Session that he and Mr. Robert Graves and Mr. Ling Graves were there to answer them.
