CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Steve Riley called the meeting to order at 3:15 p.m.

Chairman Riley said that he talked with Chairman of the Board, Paul Sommerville, and informed him of the RCLP Board's concern. Mr. Stanford said that he talked with Vice-Chairman Jerry Stewart who was willing to come in Chairman Sommerville's place when needed.
