Beaufort County Rural and Critical Land Preservation Board meeting September 13, 2012

CALL TO ORDER

Vice-Chairman Ed Pappas called the meeting to order at 3:02 p.m.

Vice-Chairman Pappas asked if there were any changes to the Agenda and there were none.

Vice-Chairman Pappas asked if there were any changes to the Minutes from July 12, 2012 Board meeting. Hearing none, Mr. Dawson made a motion and Mr. Vercellotti seconded the motion to accept the Minutes from the July 12, 2012 Board meeting. **Motion carried.**

GENERAL DISCUSSION

Vice-Chairman Ed Pappas stated that Chairman Malcolm Goodridge had resigned from the Rural and Critical Land Preservation Board as Chairman and as a member. Therefore, a new Chairman and new Vice-Chairman need to be elected. Mr. Joe Vercellotti made a motion to nominate Mr. Ed Pappas as Chairman and Ms. Selena Brown as Vice-Chairman. The motion was seconded by Ms. Brown. The Board voted and the motion carried unanimously.

Mr. Garrett Budds discussed the origin of the comprehensive protected lands baseline mapping project. He stated that this idea came about during the May 2012 meeting where the Board discussed how the Greenprint map could be used to show what has been conserved and where we need to conserve in the future. The map presented today is a baseline of what has been conserved to date. It includes properties conserved through the Rural and Critical Land Preservation Program, Beaufort County Open Land Trust, Lowcountry Open Land Trust, Ducks Unlimited, The Nature Conservancy, South Carolina Department of Natural Resources, National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration, ACE Basin Project, United States Fish and Wildlife, City of Beaufort, Town of Port Royal, Town of Bluffton, Town of Hilton Head, Marine Corps Air Station, Parris Island, Beaufort County, Jasper County, and Colleton County. This map will eventually be available on the web and will be a living document.

Mr. Budds stated that Beaufort County Open Land Trust is going to run an educational program about the Rural and Critical Land Preservation Program and its accomplishments over the last 12 years. Mr. Budds will give a presentation of the material at next month's Board meeting. The campaign group is still active and will be promoting the Rural and Critical Land Preservation Program in October.
