CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Ed Pappas called the meeting to order at 3:01 p.m.

GENERAL DISCUSSION

Ms. Patty Kennedy, with Beaufort County Open Land Trust (BCOLT) introduced Ms. Colleen Barrett and Mr. Jason Mann who represented the Marine Corps Air Station (MCAS) Community Plans and Liaison Office. Mr. Jason Mann stated that the relationship between MCAS, BCOLT, and Beaufort County Rural and Critical Land Preservation (RCLP) Program is very well known and recognized. He is very excited to keep a great working relationship with the RCLP Board, BCOLT, and the RCLP Program. Mr. Mann invited all the Board members to a cock pit demonstration on April 26, 2013 for the new jet that will be coming to the Marine Corps Air Station.

Ms. Kennedy reviewed the Property Classification List that was discussed at the RCLP Board Retreat. The idea behind this list is to use the classifications as guidelines on how to label fee simple properties coming forward for purchase through the program. The recent draft of the list is hopefully more user friendly. Ms. Kennedy would like the Board to take the draft home and return to the next meeting prepared to discuss any modification, changes, or additions. Once the edits are reviewed and completed, the Board will vote to send it on to County Council for approval.

During the RCLP Board Retreat, the role of the Board was discussed. The outcome of the Retreat was that the Board did not want to expand their role beyond acquiring properties for the program. The Board decided to send forward Ms. Kennedy's highlights of the Retreat to the Natural Resources Committee to have them decide how to deal with passive parks within Beaufort County (planning, development, and maintenance).
