#### **GENERAL DISCUSSION**

## **Financial Update**

Ms. Alicia Holland, Beaufort County Chief Financial Officer, gave an update of the R&C Program finances. Ms. Holland and her staff have developed a new and different financial report for the Board. This report includes numbers from the inception of the program through June 30, 2016. Currently the R&C Program has a total amount of \$5,053,583.00 in funds. Of this amount \$3,716,550.00 is unrestricted and \$1,337,033.00 is restricted. The restricted funds have donor specific restrictions on how these funds can be used. The Finance Department intends to issue the \$20 million referendum (approved in November 2014) by December 2016. Ms. Holland demonstrated to the Board how to access the financial report through the Beaufort County website. At this time a project ledger breakdown is being worked on between the Finance Department and the Planning Department with more details to come in the next few months.

## Passive Park Update

Mr. Tony Criscitiello stated that work had begun on Crystal Lake and that the rent from the tenants inhabiting the building will come back into the R&C Program. Fort Fremont is in the last stages of the archeological investigation and Mr. Criscitiello hopes that a bid will be sent out for this project by September. Okatie Preserve is in the process of finishing the manure management plan and will then engage in meetings with the Town of Bluffton to obtain permits for approval.

## **BCOLT Annual Report**

Ms. Lisa Lord gave out copies of the Beaufort County Open Land Trust Annual Report to the Board members. A link will be put on the R&C website to access the report online.

## **EXECUTIVE SESSION**
