Mr. Dietz reminded Mrs. Tuckwiller about the closed-circuit television stations available for announcements at several of the gated communities. Mr. Fitzgerald also encouraged staff to pass on information to Falcon Cable for publicity.

- Mr. Dietz added a comment about the collection of newspapers and magazines at Drop-Off Centers (DOC's). He asked the question about including all types of paper, including junk mail in the collections at County DOC's. Mrs. Tuckwiller said she would follow up with Art Smith at Waste Management.
- A motion was made by Carol Murphy for the Marine Corps Air Station (MCAS) to also have representation on the Solid Waste and Recycling Board. Staff of the NREAO at MCAS have expressed interest in joining the board in the same capacity as the NREAO office at MCRD Parris Island.
