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- Chairman, Doug Robertson, called the meeting to order and welcomed everyone.
 - Mr. Robertson introduced a new member of the Board, Mr. Curtis Pauling, who was appointed as the Solid Waste District #1 representative. Mr. Pauling operates Bowers Island's landfill and demolition debris landfill on Lady's Island.
 - Mr. Robertson asked for a motion to adopt the minutes of the previous meeting and second. Minutes were adopted as written.
 - The Solid Waste and Recycling budget presented by Mrs. Tuckwiller for March 1999 without comment. Mrs. Tuckwiller stated that the hauling and disposal budget was within the approved budget. The County's Controller, County Administrator, and the Board for Public Safety and Development are aware of the shortfall. The shortfall will be covered by monies originally allocated for Recycling in the year 1999 budget.
 - Mrs. Tuckwiller presented an update on the 1999 Special Telephone Directory Recycling

campaign. The collection period will be from June 25th through July 11th at the following locations: Port Royal Park at the Naval Hospital, Lady's Island Cinemas on Hwy 21 and Beaufort Plaza on Hwy 170. Mrs. Stiles added that Parris Island has several pallets of phone books on base and she would like to add them to this effort. Mrs. Tuckwiller instructed her to take them to the MRF at Hickory Hill rather than drop them off at one of the provided locations. Mr. Dietz reminded Mrs. Tuckwiller about the closed-circuit television stations available for announcements at several of the gated communities. Mr. Fitzgerald also encouraged staff to pass on information to Falcon Cable for publicity.

- Mr. Dietz added a comment about the collection of newspapers and magazines at Drop-Off Centers (DOC's). He asked the question about including all types of paper, including junk mail in the collections at County DOC's. Mrs. Tuckwiller said she would follow up with Art Smith at Waste Management.
- A motion was made by Carol Murphy for the Marine Corps Air Station (MCAS) to also have representation on the Solid Waste and Recycling Board. Staff of the NREAO at MCAS have expressed interest in joining the board in the same capacity as the NREAO office at MCRD Parris Island. Mr. Dietz seconded the motion, and the motion was unanimously passed by the voting members present.
- Mr. Robertson introduced the idea of developing a Mission Statement for the Solid Waste and Recycling Board. He asked all members of the board to begin thinking about what they would like the statement to be.
- Mr. Robertson asked the board to meet at the board of the next formal meeting on Thursday, June 25th at 10:00 AM. Mrs. Tuckwiller said she would have the work completed for him by the next meeting.
- Mr. Robertson adjourned the meeting.
