- § Chairman, Doug Robertson called the meeting to order and welcomed everyone.
- § Mr. Robertson asked for a motion to adopt the minutes from the December 16, 1999 meeting. A motion was made and seconded. Minutes were adopted as written.
- § The monthly reports were presented for November 1999 without comment.
- § Mr. Bellamy presented the information compiled for Technical Memorandum #4 of the Beaufort County Solid Waste Master Plan. Much discussion on future planning, staffing and construction of new facilities took place. Mr. Bellamy gave a review of the Public Works Department Capital Improvement Program Request for fiscal years 2001 through 2005. A significant portion of the Department's request consisted of construction of new Drop-Off Center facilities.
- § This would bring about discussion on a specified subject each month. Mrs. Tuckwiller added that she will put this on the agenda as soon as the Solid Waste Master Plan effort is

complete and endorsed by the Board.

- § Mrs. Stiles also commented that she would like to make a presentation to the Board about solid waste and recycling operations at Parris Island. The Board agreed that it would be beneficial to understand what the military bases are doing to reduce their waste. Mrs. Stiles added that a field trip to Parris Island would provide a better experience. Mr. Robertson asked that this be considered for a meeting in late spring or early summer.
