- § Chairman, Doug Robertson called the meeting to order and welcomed everyone.
- § Mr. Eversmann introduced Mr. Buz Boehm, newly appointed Deputy Administrator for Development & Services. Mr. Chuck Hoelle, Assistant Town Manager for the Town of Hilton Head was also introduced to the Board.
- § Miss Miller, of HDR Engineering, presented the Solid Waste Master Plan to the Board. A discussion regarding the recommendation that DOC employees become regular part time employees. Regular part time employee status would make the DOC Attendants eligible for health benefits. The Board also discussed the issue of increased hours at newly constructed County DOC's. The Board made a motion to endorse the SWMP. The motion was approved. The next step will be for the Board to formally adopt the Solid Waste Master Plan. This will be on the agenda for the April meeting.

- § Mr. Bellamy presented the Drop-Off Center Design to the Board. Board members reviewed the design and gave an overall approval of the work performed by HDR Engineering. Mr. Hoelle also presented the Board with the initial plans for the Hiltec property on Hilton Head Island. This is the proposed location for the new DOC in Solid Waste District #3.
- § Mr. Bellamy presented the Solid Waste and Recycling Division's Budget Concept for Fiscal Year 2001. A motion was made by Mr. Dietz and seconded by Mr. Bowers to endorse the SWR FY01 Budget Concept. The motion was passed unanimously.
