- § Minutes from the September 21, 2000, meeting were reviewed but not adopted due to lack of quorum.
- Mr. Bellamy provided a presentation on the reports for the month of August, 2000.

Mr. Bellamy updated the Board on the Composting / Mulching RFP process. There has been a complication in the bonding. However, Mr. Bellamy feels that it will be resolved soon and the process towards starting operations will be back on track.
 - Mr. Eversmann provided an update on the charge for commercially generated MSW. We have a proposal from WMI that would eventually decrease the County cost to \$0.
 - Mr. Bellamy provided an update on packer truck operations. It appears that the SWR Divisions saved between \$4,500 and \$5,000 in the first month of operations.
 - Mr. Dietz commented that the board is ready and willing to help advertise the cost saving

initiatives implemented by the staff over the past few years.
