§ Mr. Dietz called the meeting to order.

§ Minutes from the November 16, 2000, meeting were reviewed and approved.

- Mr Bellamy provided a presentation on the reports for the month of October, 2000. Mr. Bellamy commented that the packer truck operation is going well. The SWR Division appears to be saving between 10% –15% on hauling costs due to the increased operations.
- Mr. Bellamy updated the Board on the Composting / Mulching RFP process. Grind-All is making arrangements for an office, power, outside lighting, etc. to set up the sites at the Shanklin and Simmonsville sites. Grind-All hopes to start taking County yard waste sometime in January 2001.
- A 2001 meeting schedule was distributed for review; the schedule was approved for calendar year 2001.
- Mr. Bellamy reported that the method for collecting white goods at the Bluffton DOC will be

changing in the near future. Walterboro Recycling is going to eliminate the pile of white goods currently at the Bluffton DOC. Once the pile is gone, white goods will be collected in a tractor trailer. The white goods will be dropped off by citizens, and the packer truck or loader from Roads and Drainage (South) will load the white goods into the trailer. This will keep the area from becoming unsightly.
