- \$ Mrs. Murphy called the meeting to order at 2:35 pm.
- \$ Minutes from the May 24, 2001 meeting were reviewed and approval tabled until the next meeting.

- \$ Mr. Bellamy reviewed the Solid Waste and Recycling Division Monthly Reports for March & April noting that budgeted expenses are in line. He attributed savings in the hauling costs because of packer truck.
- Hauling costs in April 2001 were less than 2000 because the county received credit for a hauling bill owed from the previous year. Recycling tonnage was the same as April 2000 because some 46 tons of materials were contaminated received at the MRF.
- \$ In the Mulch Operations Update Mr. Bellamy reported that Grind All was not receiving as much tonnage as anticipated and this could be due to the bagged yard goods that the City of Beaufort takes to Barnwell Resources.
- \$ Capital Improvements Projects update noted that the offer to purchase the

Gardens Corner property was refused by the owner because the offer was too low in their opinion. The offer was above the appraised value. Public Works is considering exercising *eminent domain* for this 7.5 parcel.

- \$ The next meeting is scheduled for July 19, 2001 but members will be polled to see if enough can attend considering vacation schedules.
