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- § Mr. Dietz was out of town and Vice-Chairman Mrs. Murphy called the meeting to order at 2:00 PM. Minutes from the January 17, 2002 meeting were reviewed and approved.
- § Mr. Bellamy distributed monthly reports from the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter 2001. The reports were briefly reviewed and will be mailed to all absentees.
- § Mr. Bellamy reported that it appears that Grind All is attempting to back out of their contract with the County. They do not want to man the Shanklin Road site. He stated that our cost savings, which is actually cost avoidance, is very small and if they cannot fulfill their entire obligation we may void the contract. A general discussion followed on the difficulty for contractors to grind yard waste profitably.
- § All OSHA items except the providing of hot water to the DOC's have been remedied. The contractor will begin construction shortly. The date for abatement is March 31, 2002 and while we will have made substantial progress it is felt that an extension will be needed. There should be no problem getting the extension, as this is a non-serious violation.
- § Mr. Bellamy stated that we have purchased property on St. Helena and Engineering is in the process to put the construction for the new DOC out for bids. Engineering drawings for the Stroban Road DOC site have been completed and we are currently negotiating price with the property owner.

§ The Solid Waste and Recycling portion of the Beaufort County Comprehensive Plan is due to be completed on July 22, 2002. The Board will meet prior to the next meeting and distribute their ideas to all prior to March 21. At the next board meeting we will discuss the Comprehensive Plan in depth.

§ The meeting was adjourned at 2:35 PM. The next meeting will be held at the Public Works Conference Room on Shanklin Road at 2:00 on February 21, 2002.
