- The minutes for the February 2006 meeting were read and approved.
- The monthly report for December was reviewed and accepted.
 - Prices for mixed paper are dropping. Mr. Minor met with WM and asked that they sort cardboard to receive better price for corrugated-only-bales
 - o County received \$60,000 for cardboard plus cost avoidance for 1000tn (\$62,000)
 - O Disposal budget will be close but should be surplus in recycling and diversion
 - o Mr. Dietz passed around recent article about the Beaufort Jasper solid waste discussion.
 - Jasper and Beaufort may work together to get better prices at the landfill
 - Mr. Bellamy commented that Beaufort should be paying the average SC charge which is half of current p/ton fee
- FY 2007 Budget discussion
 - o Budget has been submitted for review to fiscal officer and Mr. Bellamy
 - o Hauling budget may be over estimated but excess may be used
 - o 3rd operation foreman requested, only personnel addition
 - o Additional advertising and office expenses for anticipated recycling projects
 - o Fuel reflects anticipated increases plus litter officers usage
 - o Mr. Bowers motioned, Mr. Stewart seconded the endorsement of the budget
- At Mr. Stewart's request, Mr. Minor reviewed the county ordinance on curbside recycling
 - Haulers only need to provide curbside if county provides
 - o Mr. Stewart will check on the PUD requirements at Sun City
- A discussion was held on the problems at the DOC's with commercial dumping and definition of what is household vs what is commercial
 - o Mr. Minor read Colleton county's ordinance as a possible model for Beaufort to more clearly define
 - What is acceptable amount at DOC
 - As of 2/2 the litter officer issued 30 tickets that netted \$1500 in fines.
- Simmonsville Rd. DOC completion is anticipated, 5/31/06. The county will receive another update 3/17/06.
- Expressions of Interest draft document for Solid Waste and Recycling was sent and returned by purchasing for corrections. The board reviewed copies of the EOI.
 - o Mr. Bowers commented on the need for a catastrophic storms disclaimer.

- Once edited, this EOI should be out in a few weeks.
- o Mr. Dietz asked that board members review and send any comments to Mr. Minor, ASAP
- o Mr. Stewart motioned, Mr. Dietz seconded that the board support the EOI concept
- The Ethics Commission Report was reviewed and discussed with the board as directed by council.
- Ms. Murphy presented the Recycling Coordinators report for February 2006. Ms. Lindsay was out of town.
 - o Mr. Minor was pleased with the progress accomplished in a month
 - o The DHEC grants were discussed, items to be requested reviewed.
 - o The Household Haz Mat pickup plans are underway with exceptional cooperation by Fire Depts.
 - o The Rechargeable Battery recycling program at all DOC's will be instituted in conjunction with Earth Day.
- The meeting was adjourned at 3:30 p.m.
- The next meeting will be held at the Public Works Conference Room at 2:00 p. m. on April 20, 2006.
