- Call to Order: Chairman Dietz called the meeting to order at 2:02.
- Minutes: Mr. Bowers motioned and Mr. Dietz seconded and the board approved the minutes from May 15, 2008.
- Monthly Reports

- o Mr. Minor reviewed April data commenting on Center tonnage anomalies.
- O Disposal and Hauling costs are well below budget

• Litter Officers' Reports

- o The vehicle camera received through the Palmetto Pride Grant was installed in Cpl Blacks vehicle
- o Cpl Black noted that covered loads are beginning to appear as evidence of success of education efforts
- o Local judges have suspended or reduced fines despite photo and other evidence
- o Signs with Secure Your Load Flyers will be delivered to local building supplies

• Recycling Coordinators Report

- o \$362.760 has been collected in recycling proceeds through mid May.
- O DHEC grant funds will be awarded in June. Total Approved \$173,352
- o Tire Grant \$106,000 APPROVED
 - 100,000 Direct Costs renovation two centers, 5,000 Public Education, 1,000 Travel
- Oil Grant \$67,352 APPROVED
 - 60,000 Site Prep renovation two centers, 5,000 Public Education, 1,000 Travel
 - 1352 Contract Services Oil filter recycling
- o Solid Waste Grant \$40,000 Denied, may reapply Oct 09
 - 36,000 Freightliner Sprinter Truck,
- o All Spring Haz Mat Collections were complete.
 - March 1,2008 Bluffton PW; 235 cars, 70 w/HH zip, COST =\$15,462, Paint = \$9,050, Non Paint items = \$6,412
 - May 3, 2008 Shanklin PW; 225 cars, COST = \$28,110 cost Paint \$16,875, Non Paint items \$9,555, Fluorescent bulbs \$1,680, Grand total = \$43,572
- o Paint total = \$25,925 or 59% of total Haz Mat Cost
- o Paint pouring project saved a minimum of \$3500
 - 5 Days of Attendant Training to accommodate 42 attendants, Trainers: SW Manger, Ops Managers, Litter Officers, RC and WM Rep
 - Topics: Standard Operating Procedures, Attitude and customer service, Law enforcement issues,
- Lady's Island Middle Recycling Project; Donna McCoy and students sitting by 1.5 Tons of workbooks and other paper collected as part of recycling project at their school. RC presented 4 classroom programs & coordinated project. End of Year Material Estimate 5.0 Tons p/School x 27 schools = 135 tons of potential mixed paper

• New Business

- Closing of Hickory Hill on Sunday
 - Hickory Hill landfill will now be closed on Sundays making it difficult to manage our waste disposal of

centers.

- There would be overwhelming savings in hours and fuel, approximately \$100,000+.
- A survey of 27 other counties was made and Beaufort is the only full service county on Sunday, 8 other counties were open but with limited afternoon hours.
- The pros and cons were discussed by the board.
- o FY09 Budget is being finalized; no new personnel and no new equipment
- o Recycling RFP was released and pre bid mandatory meeting was held with 12 haulers/processors attending.
 - 7/16 is deadline for proposals; 7/16-30 proposals will be judged by committee
 - Results will be sent to public service committee August meeting
 - New contract should begin 10/1 at the latest
 - Mr. Bowers Motions, Mr. Uehling seconded and all approved that Mr. Dietz be the SWR Board Rep.
 - The current contract expires 6/30/08. We will be on a month-to-month status until.
- o Change of Date for July/Aug Meetings
 - Because of the Recycling RFP it was requested to change the meeting dates to one meeting.
 - The Board approved this request. to 7/31/08 2:00 pm.
- o Hauling Contract Price Increase
 - This contract change is to go before council at their next meeting. Mr. Minor noted Republics
 exceptional service as true partner and deserved this increase of \$95 to \$102 to accommodate fuel
 increases.
 - Mr. Bowers moved and Mr. Uehling seconded and the board approved getting approval for Republic to take waste to Savannah and charge \$45 p/ton when Hickory Hill is closed (HH is now closed on Sunday)
- Town of Hilton Head Recycling efforts
 - Jeff Moran reported that the Town is still investigating options.
 - They have implemented recycling at 8 town parks.
 - They are waiting for the consultants findings on the Pay as You Throw Proposal.
- Ladies Island Renovations
 - Design is complete and RFB is out on web site..
- o New Burton Convenience Center
 - RFP is complete and out on web site.
