- o Solid Waste Grant \$40,000 Reapply for 2 OCC compactors for Shanklin and Lady's Island centers
- o RC met with several schools interested in recycling and has been in contact with district officials.

- o Recycling RFP
 - The RFP proposals have been ranked: Republic, Waste Management and Waste Pro. RW Beck is drafting the contract for negotiations with Republic.
 - The draft is due the end of September aiming for 10/14 Public Services Committee meeting.
 - Mr. Bellamy noted that Mr. Dietz did an excellent job as the SWRB representative.
- o Hilton Head Recycling
 - Mr. Becker reported that HH would be meeting with their consultant 10/1 on the Pay as you Throw option.
 - The Beach program is underway and seems to be doing well.
- Ladies Island Renovations
 - Design is almost complete and almost ready for bid
- o New Convenience Center on Shanklin Road
 - RFP has been evaluated and awaiting approval by Public Services Comm in Sept.
 - The current Shanklin center will be left as is after the new center opens. It could be a storm debris site.
