- 1. Call to Order:** Chairman Boehme called the meeting to order at 2:00 pm.
 - A. Agenda:** Chairman Boehme requested a motion to approve the agenda. Ms. Corley motioned. Mr. Bennett seconded. All approved the agenda.
 - B. Minutes:** Chairman Boehme requested a motion to approve the May 23, 2019 minutes. Ms. Corley motioned. Mr. Bennett seconded. All approved the minutes.
- 2. Introductions:** All attendees introduced themselves.
- 3. Public Comment:** There was no public comment. Chairman Boehme reminded attendees that there will be an aggressive schedule in the upcoming months.
- 4. Reports from Board regarding meetings with Council Members:**
 - Ms. Corley suggested combining resources from various counties for transfer stations
 - Mr. Vaigneur suggested awareness regarding landfills
- 5. Reports:**
 - A. SW&R Monthly Reports – May and June 2019:**
 - Ms. Carter reported on the end of FY19 with May and June data
 - Collection of waste has shifted: 45% Convenience Center; 55% curbside
 - County generated 82,379.03 tons of waste in FY19 (28% increase over 5 years)
 - Both hauling and disposal exceeded anticipated FY19 budget
 - 5-year expenditures increased \$1,270,741.84 for hauling and disposal
 - FY19 Convenience Center traffic = 1,755,359 vehicles
 - Annual recycling estimated at 12% of total waste generated
 - Revenue for FY19 \$90,207.20; shortage of \$214,790.97 per recycle processing
