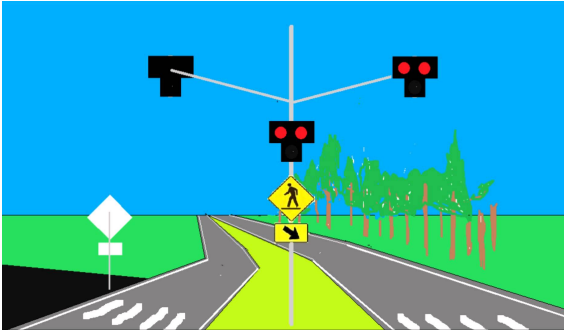
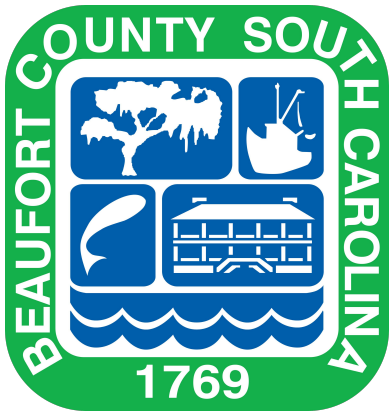


How does a HAWK Signal Work?

Will see this...

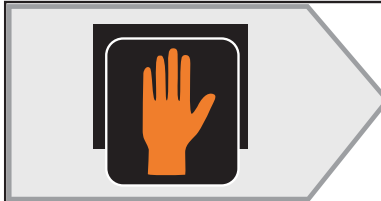


Will do this...

Push button to call for WALK signal
(some locations automatically detect pedestrians)



Wait
(It may take up to one minute for the signal to change)



Wait



Start crossing after you see the WALK signal
(Be sure traffic has stopped)



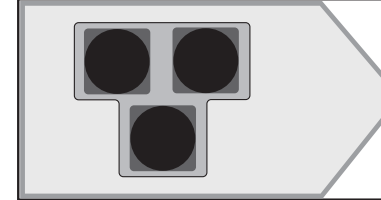
Continue Crossing

Push the button to cross

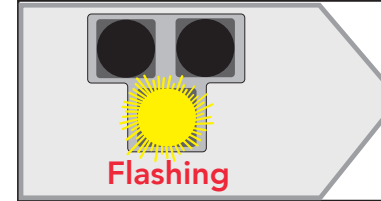

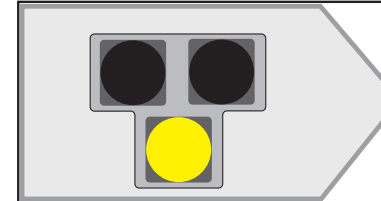

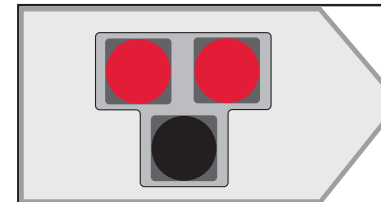
Proceed



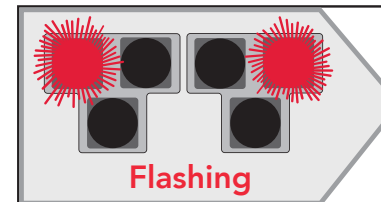
Proceed with Caution
(Signal has been activated)



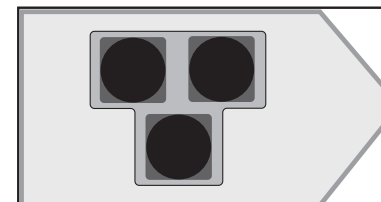
Slow down and prepare to STOP
